Vs. 3-Explanation—"Know ye that the Lord he is God" d. Vs. 4-Expression—"Enter into His gates with thanksgiving" e. Vs. 5-Extension—"Mercy-everlasting, truth-endureth"

	<u>1. Worship Recognizes God As King—Vs. 1</u> Verse #1: " <u>Make</u> a joyful noise unto the Lord, <u>all ye lands</u> ."
60	 The 1st Admonishment. a. <u>The word make</u> = to cause to happen, it is a command to bring into existence, to appear.
Ę	b. <u>The word joyful</u> = an expression or a feeling of exuberance. 7 times in the book of Psalms we are commanded to make a joyful noise unto God (<i>for the King</i>)
	c. <u>All ye lands</u> = Symbolic of People of every nations and tongue.

	Verse #2: " <u>Serve</u> the Lord with <u>gladness</u> : <u>come</u> before his <u>presence</u> with <u>singing</u> ."
SERVE	2nd & 3rd Admonishments.
	a) <u>Serve</u> 2nd = to wait upon, to be of use
	b) <u>Gladness</u> = having a cheerful or happy disposition and nature, pleased, satisfied.
E	c) <u>Come</u> / <u>Presence</u> 3rd = an invitation to move in the vicinity of with a specified purpose.
	d) <u>Signing</u> = to relate or celebrate something in song, with praise

CONNECT	3 Know ye that the LORD he is God: it is he that hath made us, and not we ourselves; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture.
	If you have truly trusted Jesus as your Savior, you have been born again into the Family of God. John 1:12
GO	12 Yet to all who received him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God 13 children born not of natural descent, nor of human decision or a husband's will, but born of God.
Ê	Jesus is the Good Shepherd.
	John 10:27 My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. 28 I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish; no one can snatch them out of my hand. 29 My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than all; no one can snatch them out of my Father's hand. 30 I and the Father are one."

Ê	 □ (v4) The Hebrew here for "<u>enter into</u>" means: ✓ Continuous action (His presence has no end) ✓ As movement occurs (His presence requires order) ✓ At the same time (There is collective in worship)
